Leviticus 20:7-8




The name Jehovah-M'Kaddesh, “The Eternally Self-Existent One Who Sanctifies” probably describes the character of God more than any other name.

“Holy, Sanctify” = Use and Definition.

It appears 700 times in the Bible.

1. "Sanctify" primarily means to set apart or separate.
2. The words "holy" and "hallow" are often used for "sanctify" and stand for what has been set apart unto God.
3. The word "saint" speaks of an individual who has been sanctified.

Above him were seraphim, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. How does God make us holy?



**Holiness is something being separated from
“common” use to sacred**

**Holiness in the Old Testament was a literal
separation of people into a nation**



For you are **a people holy to the Lord your God.**
The Lord your God has **chosen you out of (separated)** all the peoples on the face of the earth to be his people, his treasured possession.
The Lord did not set his affection on you and choose you because you were more numerous than other peoples, for you were the fewest of all peoples. **Deuteronomy 7:6-7**



**In the Old Testament holiness was racial
and political.**

**In the New Testament, holiness was an
invitation to The Kingdom of Heaven**

“Not everyone who says to me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ will **enter the kingdom of heaven**, but only the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.”

Matthew 7:21

Then Jesus said to his disciples, “Truly I tell you, it is hard for someone who is rich **to enter the kingdom of heaven.**” **Matthew 19:23**

Jesus answered, “Very truly I tell you, no one can **enter the kingdom** of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit.” **John 3:5**

But you are a **chosen people**, a **royal priesthood**, a **holy nation**, God's **special possession**, that you may declare the praises of him who called you **out of darkness into his wonderful light**. Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; **1 Peter 2:9-10**

Dear friends, I urge you, as **foreigners** and **exiles**, to abstain (distance, separation) from sinful desires, which wage war against your soul. **vs 11**

But just as he who called you is holy (separate), so be holy (separate) in all you do; **vs 15**

So I tell you this, and insist on it in the Lord, that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their thinking. They are darkened in their understanding and **separated from the life of God** because of the ignorance that is in them due to the hardening of their hearts. **Ephesians 4:17-18**

You were taught, with regard to your **former way of life**, to put off your **old** self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made **new** in the attitude of your minds; and to **put on the new self**, created to be like God in true **righteousness and holiness. vs 22-24**

How does God make us holy?

It is an action (His part) and a decision (our part)
and a process (our everyday part)

We then take the many layers of our life and give them piece by piece to God (make holy).

“If anyone comes to me and does not hate father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters—yes, even their own life—such a person cannot be my disciple.” **Luke 14:26**

“Woe to me!” I cried. “I am ruined! For I am a **man of unclean lips**, and I live **among a people of unclean lips**, and my eyes have seen the King, the Lord Almighty.”

Isaiah 6:5

Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with tongs from the altar. With it he touched my mouth and said, “See, this has touched your lips; **your guilt is taken away** and **your sin atoned for.**” **vs 6-7**

Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, “Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?” And I said, “Here am I. Send me!” **vs 8**
