Micah 6:8 - Review

- Themes: Doom and Hope
- God was judge and witness of their sin which included the corruption of: 1) Worship: Worshipping the work of human hands. 2) Justice: Myth that affluence equals justice. 3) Charity: Is a form of affluence management. 4) Righteousness: Replacing righteousness that comes from God with self-righteousness.

Micah 6:8

He has told you, oh man, what is good; And what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God. (ESV)

“do justice”

Is it justice or is it actually just us?

“love kindness”

Hesed (a noun) means loving-kindness (or steadfast love). It is based in God’s covenant loyalty and not our own.

“walk humbly with your God”

God’s covenant example of hope was sacrificial

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
